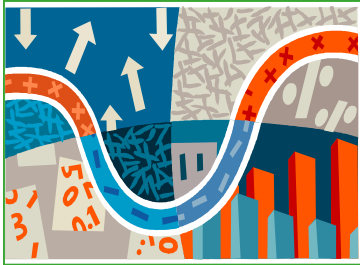


What is SCHOOL_MATES?
